A: Chocolates are best shipped under moderate temperatures. When we ship to warmer climates we take precautions to use coolers, ice packs, or next-day shipping services.

Q: Food Allergy Statement?

A: Our chocolates are manufactured in a facility that also processes peanuts, tree nuts, eggs, wheat, soy, coconut and dairy products.

Q: Should chocolate be refrigerated?

A: Chocolate is best served between 68 and 70 degrees.
